The Problem

Bradgate's IT infrastructure has grown from a network of 5 PCs in 1997 to more than 100 PCs and 8 servers on three sites, today. Bradgate wanted to provide Internet access to all users. Due to a rural location a broadband connection is not available, so getting the best from the ISDN connection is key. Billy Hammond was looking for a simple solution that can be implemented quickly and will operate with the minimum of administration allowing him and his team to concentrate their valuable resource in other areas.

Why NetProxy?

Bradgate reviewed a number of leading Proxy Servers. NetProxy was selected after an extended test. It is simple to deploy and requires almost no administration. Grok's policy of offering minor releases and upgrades at no cost was also considered a significant plus. NetProxy has been deployed on an NT workstation and runs with no attention.

Hardware routers were evaluated and were considered expensive in comparison. Software solutions built into the servers such as Microsoft IAS were felt to be difficult to set-up and time costly to maintain.
