The Problem

Wesco's IT infrastructure grew quickly to a network of 80 PCs and 11 servers. Wesco wanted to provide Internet access across the entire network. Gareth Lodge was looking for a simple solution that could be implemented quickly and would operate with the minimum of administration, allowing him and his team to concentrate their valuable resource in other areas.

Why NetProxy?

Wesco has used NetProxy since April '99, upgrading through many releases. Original selection was made on the basis of the simplicity of set-up and ease of maintenance. Wesco currently use a 2M, E1 link connected to the network to service their web servers and NetProxy server.

Wesco has found that as the IT infrastructure has expanded as the company has grown, NetProxy has continued to provide an excellent service now serving the needs of 70+ users. Early implementation was on NT, which has now been migrated to Win 2000.

"In over 3 years of use I can only recall a handful of minor problems. Given the speed in which we have grown as a company, this has helped significantly by freeing up time for other important tasks", Gareth Lodge.
